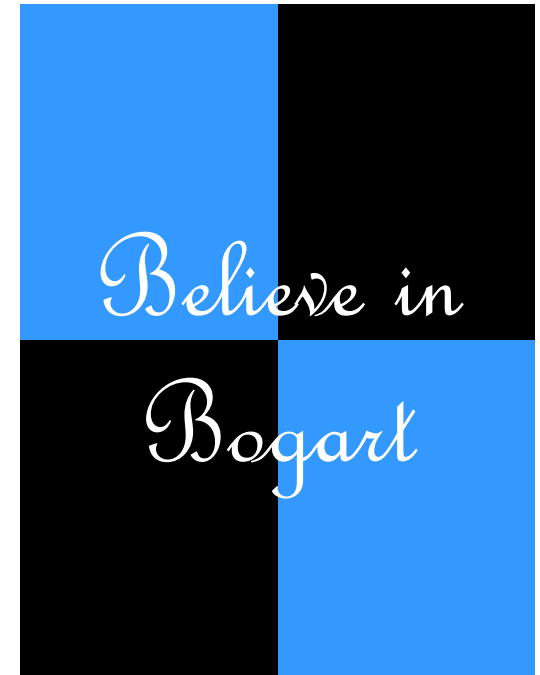

## Bogart Mission Statement

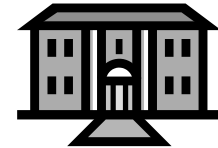
