Thursday. Guidelines for limb service:

*** Stack small limbs and branches (that have fallen from natural causes) neatly in a pile near the curb.

***Limit pile not to exceed 6ft long by6 ft. wide by 4ft. deep.

***Limbs no larger than 6in.in diameter for pick up.

***One ¾ ton pick-up truck load maximum per household.

***Pine cones should be placed in a container for pick-up with limbs.

***Please do not place any limbs in ditches.
Note: the city is not equipped to handle trees that you cut or have had cut by a tree service.
Bogart City Limb Service is for yard debris from natural causes only. Debris will not be picked up if these guidelines are not followed.

OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS

There are posted Speed Limit signs on all city streets. For the safety of all our citizens, especially children and those walking and riding bicycles, please observe the speed limits.

NOISE ordinance: Excessive and loud noises, including music, are prohibited after 11 pm. Discharging a firearm within City limits is against the law.

Please remember the **leash law** when walking your dog. We also ask that you be respectful of our community and your neighbors and pick up any excrement left behind by your dog — be a

"pooper scooper"! Thanks!

Please NOTE

The **Open Burning Ban** prohibits citizens and businesses from **burning** yard and land-clearing debris from May 1 through September 30. This is in addition to the rule that **prohibits the burning** of household garbage. **Burning** household garbage is never allowed anywhere in Georgia.
