Regular Session: January 3, 2022

### Historical Agricultural Building

#### Stormwater Engineering Project

#### Sidewalk Project – Phase III

Bryan Caffrey with Carter and Sloope presented plan options to continue the sidewalk from Landrum Drive to Burson. After review and discussing easements and cost effectiveness, council consensus was to pursue the retain wall option. Currently, the proposed amount costs \$334K. There may be additional costs for handrails not included in the drawing. John motioned that this be tabled until the February meeting to allow for 100% drawings were presented. These drawings will be at City Hall for review.

Oconee County returned to the city for approval the re-combination of Gateway parcels. Brenda motioned to approve. David seconded the motion. All approved
