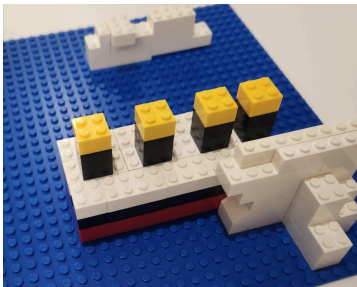

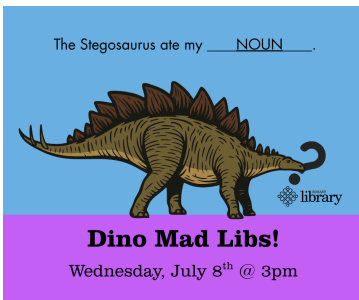


Ancient Egyptian Necklace Craft

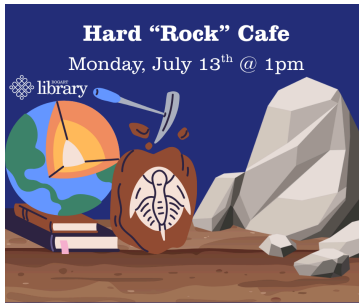

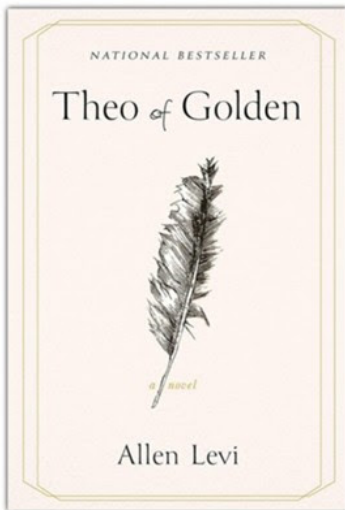

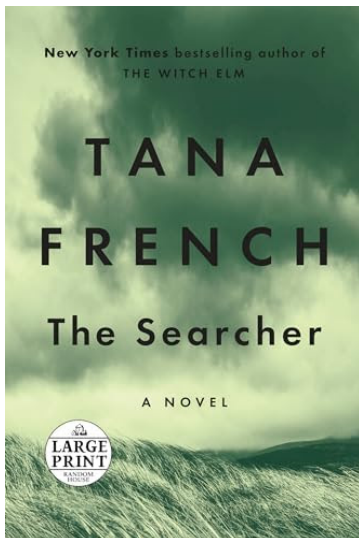
Dig Up Your Roots
