Conference Room | Monday, June 1st | 1pm

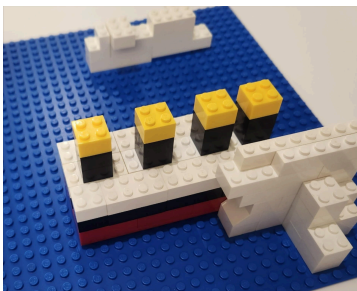

Join Ms. Harli to explore different dinosaur fossils! We will be constructing fossils using dry pasta.

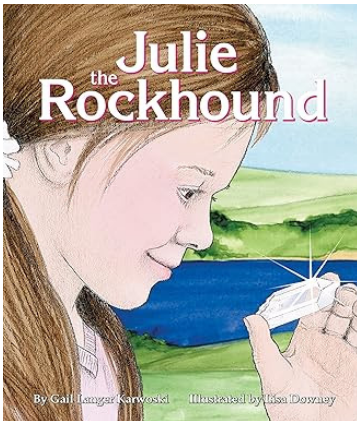


LEGO Mania!

Conference Room | Friday, June 5th | 2pm

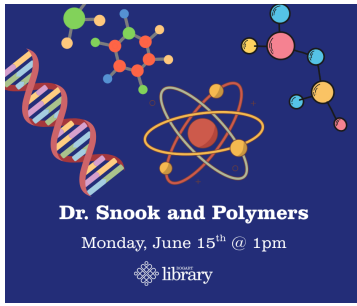
Meet author Gail Karwoski and listen to her read from her children's book.

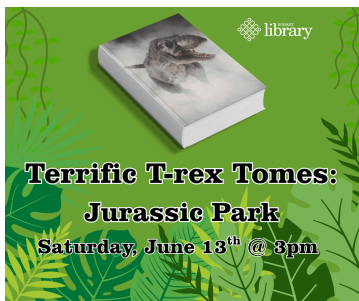

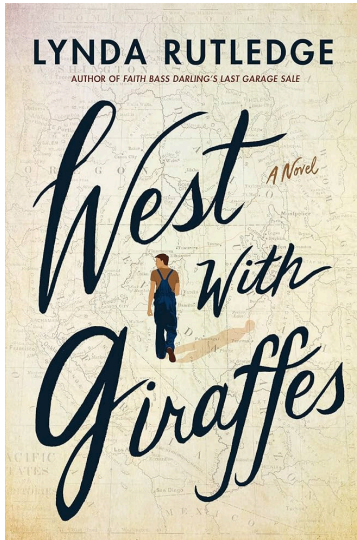
Escape from Jurassic Park

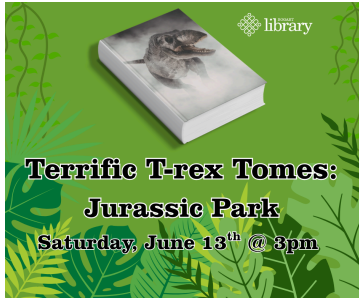

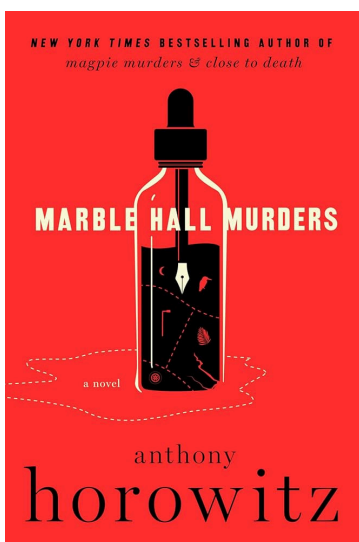
Dig Up Your Roots
