Maintenance Department Garbage/Recycle Schedule

WEEKLY

Garbage Pickup is in three phases: (please put cans out by Monday morning)

Phase 1 - begins Monday at 7:00 am

Phase 2 - begins Monday after Phase 1 is dumped (around noon)

Phase 3 - begins Tuesday at 7:00 am



Please leave cans out until emptied. This schedule is barring any equipment malfunction, bad weather, etc.

BI-WEEKLY

Recycle Pickup is in three phases: (please put cans out by Tuesday morning)

Phase 1 - begins at Tuesday pm

Phase 2 - begins Wednesday am

Phase 3 - begins Wednesday following Phase 2 disposal



Please leave cans out until emptied. This schedule is barring any equipment malfunction, bad weather, etc.

Limb Pick-Up Guidelines

The City of Bogart provides limb and yard debris pick-up free of charge to our citizens. The City is not equipped to handle any trees that you cut or have cut by a tree service. Limb pick-up is strictly for yard debris left by *natural causes*.

Stack small dried limbs and branches neatly in a pile near the curb.

Limit your pile to 6ft long by 6ft wide and 4ft deep

Limbs no larger than 5-6 inches in diameter are picked up

One standard truckload maximum per household

Place all pine cones in a container
