Qualifying and General Election Notice

Pursuant to GA Election Code (O.C.G.A. 21-2-9), the City of Bogart will conduct a General Election on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 during the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the Bogart Community Center located at 141 E. Thompson Street.

Two Council seats and the office of Mayor will be elected to fill a four-year term. Each seat will commence on January 1, 2024 and will expire on December 31, 2027. Candidates desiring to qualify may do so during the hours of 8:30 am until 4:00 pm on August 21, 22, 24 and 25, 2023 and from 8:30 am until 1:00 pm on August 23, 2023.

Candidates for council must be twenty-one years of age, a United States citizen, a resident of the city for at least six months immediately prior to qualifying and be a qualified elector. The qualifying fee is \$144.00.

Candidates for Mayor must be twenty-five years of age, a United States citizen, a resident of the city for at least twelve months immediately prior to qualifying and be a qualified elector. The qualifying fee is \$324.00.

Early voting will be held at the Historical Agricultural Building, located at 125 E. Thompson Street on the following schedule: October 15 – 21, October 23 – 28 and October 30 – November 3, 2023. Weekday hours are 8 am until 4 pm. Saturday hours are 9 am until 4 pm.

All qualified voters of the City of Bogart may vote in this General Election. Voter registration deadline is October 10, 2023.
