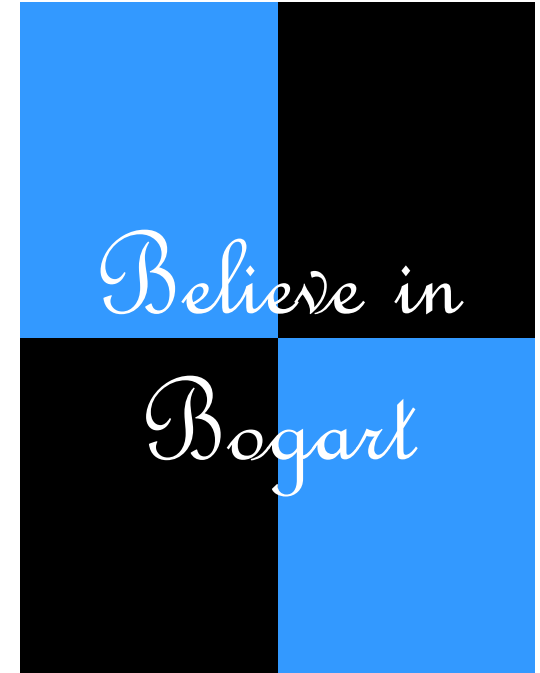
Bogart Mission Statement

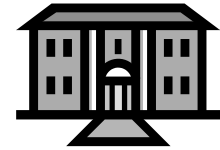

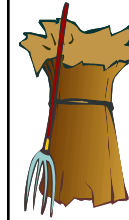
