Thank you Fred, Johnny and George for your hard work!

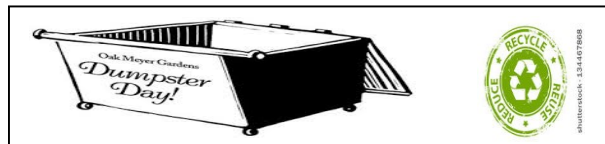
Services will not be provided if guidelines are not followed.
