**LIMB PICK-UP** up is every Thursday. This service is provided for limbs that have fallen from natural causes and weather, not from landscaping by residents. Advance voting will be available Tuesday, October 12-Friday October 15, Monday, October 18- Friday, October 22, and Monday, October 25 - Friday, October 29 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m on each day. Additionally, advanced voting will be open on Saturday October 16 and Saturday October 23 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
