"Keep it Clean, Drains to Stream"

When washing your car, use environmentally friendly products and consider washing on grass, gravel, or a porous area to prevent wash water from reaching storm drains that lead directly to rivers or streams; litter on drains can cause flooding and washed-away debris in waterways harms drinking water, recreation, and wildlife, so dispose of trash properly and pick up litter to safeguard the environment; additionally, rain gardens capture rainwater runoff from lawns and driveways, allowing it to soak into the ground rather than flowing into storm drains and polluting nearby waterways.
