Leaf & Limb Pick-Up

For leaf and limb pick up, contact City Hall or Maintenance to a schedule pick-up.

Limbs must be stacked in a pile not to exceed 6ft by 4ft deep. They must be located in the right-of-way.

For leaf pick up, use a biodegradable bag, and the city will pick up no more than 3 bags per scheduled trip.
