## Watching for Water Wasters

### Bathroom:

Check for toilet leaks by adding food coloring to the tank. If the toilet is leaking, color will appear in the bowl within 30 minutes. Check the toilet for worn out, corroded, or bent part. Consider purchasing LowFlor toilet that can reduce inrodwater use by 20%.

Avoid flushing the toilet unnecessarily. Dispose of tissues, insects, and other similar waste in the trash rather than the toilet.
