2025 City Election!

The City of Bogart will conduct a General Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, during the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the Bogart Community Center located at 141 E. Thompson Street to fill two Council seats. Council seats are a four-year term. Each seat will commence on January 2, 2026, and will expire on December 31, 2029. **Candidates desiring to qualify may do so during the hours of 8:30 am until 4:30 pm on August 18-22, 2025.** Council candidates must be twenty-one years of age, a United States citizen, a resident of the city for at least six months immediately before qualifying, and be a qualified elector. The qualifying fee is \$144.00.

The City of Bogart will hold early voting at the Historical Agricultural Building, located at 125 E. Thompson Street, on October 14 –18, October 20 –25, and October 27 –31. Weekday hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Saturday hours are 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. For both the General Election and Early Voting, **Poll workers are needed.** We need a minimum of three workers during the time the polls are open. If you are interested in serving as a poll worker, contact Jenny Jordan, Elections Coordinator, at jennywjordan@gmail.com or 706-340-6647. Poll workers receive compensation for their hours as well as training for the role. Our election is by paper ballot and does not require training for voting machines. **This is our first election where our Bogart election is at the Community Center, and county, state, and national elections are at other precincts. Please check your voter registration card for the location of your other polling location.**
